What is a Wiki?

- A secure area in which invited professionals, schools and parents can use to add content
- A bespoke systems which is tailored to young people and which they can be part of to make their voices heard about their daily lives and aspirations

- Key areas will be included such as videos linked to key routines of the day and important personalised information

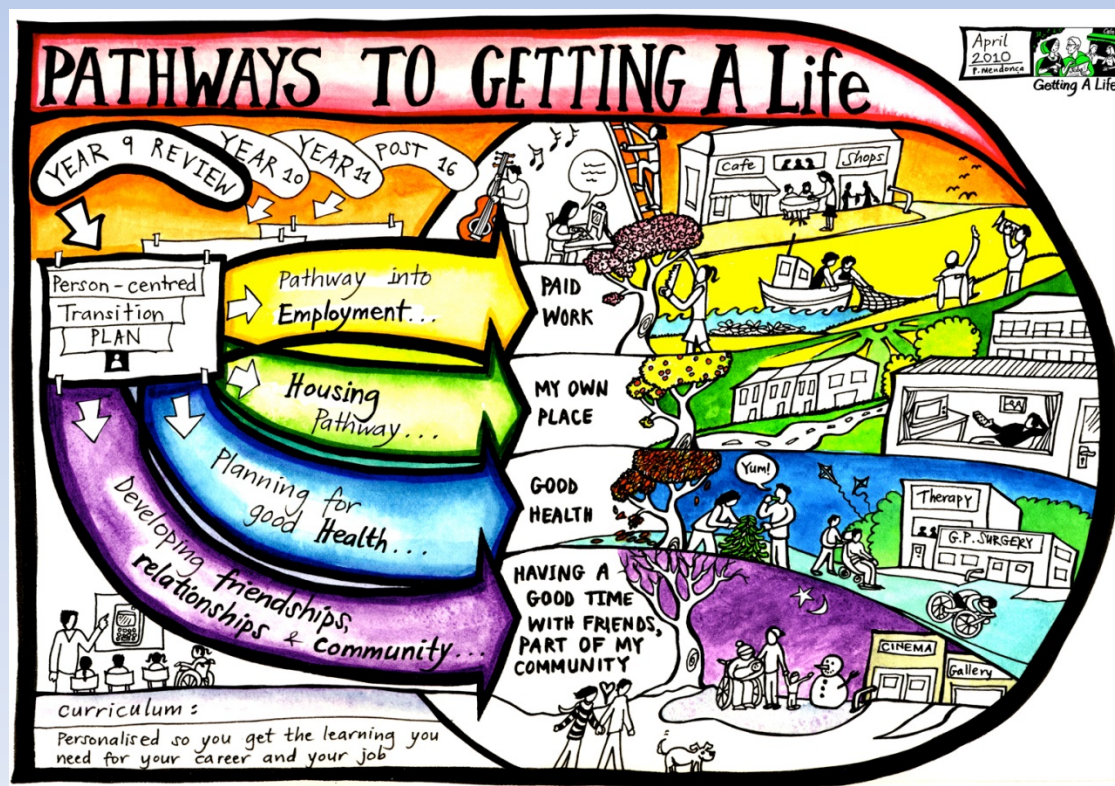
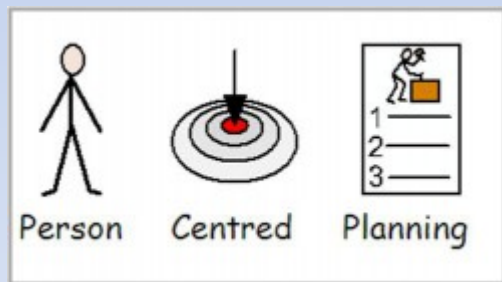


What happens next?

- School documentation such as speech and language reports, medical information and behavioural documentation will be available in a centralised format for parents, professionals and the school to share
- Students will be introduced to their wikis and will begin to contribute to adding content about what is important to them, aiding person centred planning
