Dear Parents and Carers

We are continuing to review the situation at Bradstow in relation to our staff numbers currently attending work, and therefore our capacity to support young people at the school safely, but also in line with our Covid-19 whole school risk assessment. Our risk assessment considers the phased reopening of the provision for the young people who attend the school during term times and the actions that are required to keep all in the Bradstow Community safe.

This week we have returned a small number of young people to the school. At the beginning of next week we will review whether we have the capacity and safe environment to return another small number of young people. This will be done in line with our risk assessment, and including the consideration of the staffing numbers available and whether there are any young people who are symptomatic, or any confirmed cases of Covid-19 among staff or young people on site at that point in time. The access for testing of keyworkers is improving for us now, and this will certainly help us in managing staff attendance.

In anticipation of your child's return to school, please let Liz Child or Paul Gorham know if anyone in your household or your child has been symptomatic when they contact you? This will help inform and update our risk assessments.
