Dear Parents and Carers

In light of the announcements this week, and another period of increased restrictions for us all, I thought it would be timely to update you on the additional actions the school will be taking over the coming weeks to keep our community safe.

The school's full risk assessment for Covid-19 can be found on the school's website. The Senior Leadership Team will continue to be meeting regularly to review this in line with guidance from Government.

The optional weekend, from Friday 27th November to Sunday 29th November, and visits home will go ahead as planned. Please notify us if anybody in your household is symptomatic or self-isolating during the 14 days prior to this weekend or visit if it is planned for your child to come home? Also, if your child, or anyone in your household, is symptomatic whilst at home please inform the school as this will prevent their returning to school. All visits home for young people will continue to be risk assessed.

In addition parental visits to children and young people whilst at school will be risk assessed individually and will be facilitated and supported either offsite, or in the specified areas on site i.e. in the swimming pool garden or downstairs in Ty Bach House. We will not be able to accommodate overnight stays on site in Ty Bach at this time, but we will continue to review this in the coming months. Please contact us with any requests for dates for visits?

Young people will not use public transport over the next four weeks. They will also not visit shops, but will go offsite for exercise e.g. parks and walks. They can visit outside cafes.

We will be reducing the presence of non-contact staff on the school site and requiring these staff to wear masks as they move around the school site. We will be limiting numbers in our offices, communal areas and in all meetings, and we will continue to hold meetings and reviews virtually. This will include training, school assemblies, performances, Annual Reviews and LAC Reviews.

If there is a positive case of Covid-19 on the school site we are obliged to take guidance from our Public Health advisor. We have procedures in place if this were to occur in relation to the residential homes self-isolating if required.
