Dear Parents and Carers

We are continuing to review the situation at Bradstow, along with the directorate at Wandsworth, in regards to ensuring we have safe and effective staffing capacity to enable our young people to return to the school in the coming weeks.

The young people will not return to school on 20th April, but I will contact you all during that week to update you on the plans for reopening the term time provision at the school over the coming weeks. This will give the management the opportunity to review the available staff across the classes and residential provision, and also whether the school itself is symptom free, and therefore a safe place to return to.

In preparation for this please will you inform Paul Gorham or Liz Chard, when they call you, if either your child or someone in your household has had symptoms of coronavirus in the last 14 days? They will ask you this question each time they call and use this information to update our individual risk assessments at the school.

Please do not hesitate to contact us if there is any support you require during this time? Learning resources and information about the Coronavirus is available on the school website. We can also provide visual communication aids for you to use at home, or social stories about the current situation and the virus, or learning resources for you to use at home, and behavioural support.

We have truly appreciated how understanding and supportive all our parents and carers have been at this unprecedented time. Please be assured that we are all at Bradstow focused on returning the young people to their routines at school as soon as it is safe to do so?
